FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

On the third Sunday in July, our Pentecost Gospel reading was one of the better-known stories from the Gospel According to St. Luke; that is, the story of Jesus being welcomed into Mary and Martha's home. Five verses describe how, while Jesus is visiting, Martha is doing many tasks as her sister, Mary, sits at Jesus' feet listening to Him. Martha points out to Jesus that she is doing all the work and asks Him to get Mary to help her. Jesus, however, tells Martha that, by sitting at His feet and listening to Him, Mary has "*chosen the better part.*" (Luke 10: 38-42)

This passage, found only in St. Luke's Gospel, has spawned many a sermon about discerning whether we, both as individuals and congregations, are "Marthas" or "Marys". Are we always running around, getting things done in the church? Do you measure your relationship with God by the things you "do" for God? Of course, in our culture, where we have turned time and busy-ness into a status symbol - and we like to tell others how little time we have because we are soooooo busy – it's natural that we judge ourselves and our churches by how busy we are.

Make no mistake, what Martha was doing, working her many tasks, was important; in Middle Eastern culture, hospitality is of utmost importance. Yet, in these verses, Jesus explains that being busy isn't the better part. Likewise, what we do at Trinity in mission and in ministry is important; it is part of the visible sign to the rest of our families, friends, community, and the world at large of our identity, and faith, as disciples of Christ. Yet, it's not the better part.

The better part, as told to us by Jesus, is sitting at His feet and listening to what He teaches. As we cope with this hot and humid Pennsylvania summer, there are times during the day when all the heat and humidity makes you want to sit down and rest from your many tasks. So, how about inviting Jesus to sit down with you? Or better still, how about picking up your Bible and turning to your favorite Gospel - or any of the Gospels –

and **sitting at Jesus' feet** and listening to what He has to say to you?

Sitting at our Lord and Master's feet requires nothing more than listening to Him. It can be a well-known Gospel passage or it can be one that you pick at random. It can be reading the *Celebrate* insert or your daily devotional. Whatever you choose, just sit, read, and let your mind fall silent. Let Jesus come to you in His written word and in your heart. Ignore those feelings that you need to be doing something, ignore the many tasks which seek to separate you from Christ. Even if you are usually more like Martha, take some time every day to be like Mary and spend time listening, learning, and just being with your Lord and Savior. Choose "*the better part,*" as God's Son has said, and just sit at Jesus' feet.

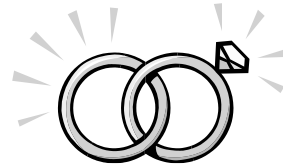

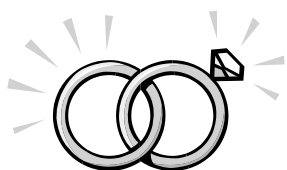
